

## Post Graduate Certificate Program Full Time Progression Plan - FNP Focus

The post-graduate certificate program requires a minimum of 16 credit hours. The program prepares graduate level nurses to sit for the national certification examination as a family nurse practitioner.

Each student's program will be individualized based on educational and experiential background. Prerequisites to registration for the four required courses in the program are evidence of competence in the following three areas: advanced pathophysiology, advanced pharmacotherapeutics, and advanced assessment.
